| Standard Learning Disability (Psychoeducational) Evaluation (Child/Teen): This evaluation looks at intellectual functioning (IQ), academic functioning, brief visual-motor assessment (fine motor), and a screening of emotional and behavioral issues. | \$1600 Appt: 3-4 hours |
| Learning Disability Evaluation + Diagnostic Evaluation (Child/Teen) This evaluation looks at intellectual functioning (IQ), academic functioning, and ADHD, ASD, mood, anxiety, and behavior, as well as daily living skills and related issues (as needed). | \$2000 Appt: 5-6 hours |
| Brief Evaluation for Diagnosis Only (Adult/Child/Teen): When specific diagnoses are suspected, this evaluation uses interview and psychometric instruments to determine if someone meets diagnostic criteria for ADHD, Autism Spectrum Disorder, depressive and mood disorders, and personality disorders. This evaluation does <u>not</u> include cognitive or academic testing. | \$1000 Appt: 2 hours (+ additional family member interviews as needed) |
